1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 10-31-13 of the North Dakota
2 Century Code, relating to regulation of professional organizations; and to amend and reenact
3 section 10-31-06 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to ownership of professional
4 organizations.

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 10-31-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is
7 amended and reenacted as follows:

8 **10-31-06. Executives and owners.**

- 9 1. ~~No~~An individual may ~~be~~not simultaneously be an executive or owner of more than one
10 professional organization rendering the same professional service.
- 11 2. A professional organization in the form of a corporation which has only one
12 shareholder need have only one director, who must be the shareholder. That individual
13 also shall serve as the president and treasurer of the corporation. The other officers of
14 the corporation need not be licensed or otherwise legally authorized in the same field
15 of endeavor as the president.
- 16 3. A retired individual may not continue as an executive or owner of a professional
17 organization.

18 **SECTION 2.** A new subsection to section 10-31-13 of the North Dakota Century Code is
19 created and enacted as follows:

20 In order to regulate organizations that have ownership that renders more than one
21 professional service, the secretary of state shall collect one thousand dollars for
22 articles of incorporation for a corporation, articles of organization for a limited liability
23 company, or articles of amendment related to an organization that has ownership that
24 renders more than one professional service. This fee is in addition to the fees provided

- 1 for these filings under section 10-19.1-147 or 10-32-150. Fees collected by the
- 2 secretary of state under this subsection must be deposited in the secretary of state's
- 3 general services operating fund.
