1 A BILL for an Act to provide for collaboration in developing diabetes goals and plans.

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

3 **SECTION 1.**

4 **Diabetes goals and plans - Report to legislative management.**

5 1. The department of human services, state department of health, Indian affairs  
6 commission, and public employees retirement system shall collaborate to identify  
7 goals and benchmarks while also developing individual agency plans to reduce the  
8 incidence of diabetes in the state, improve diabetes care, and control complications  
9 associated with diabetes.

10 2. Before June 1 of each even-numbered year the department of human services, state  
11 department of health, Indian affairs commission, and public employees retirement  
12 system shall submit a report to the legislative management on the following:

13 a. The financial impact and reach diabetes is having on the agency, the state, and  
14 localities. Items included in this assessment must include the number of lives with  
15 diabetes impacted or covered by the agency, the number of lives with diabetes  
16 and family members impacted by prevention and diabetes control programs  
17 implemented by the agency, the financial toll or impact diabetes and diabetes  
18 complications places on the agency's programs, and the financial toll or impact  
19 diabetes and diabetes complications places on the agency's programs in  
20 comparison to other chronic diseases and conditions.

21 b. An assessment of the benefits of implemented programs and activities aimed at  
22 controlling diabetes and preventing the disease. This assessment must document  
23 the amount and source for any funding directed to the agency from the legislative  
24 assembly for programs and activities aimed at reaching those with diabetes.

- 1           c. A description of the level of coordination existing between the agencies on  
2           activities, programmatic activities, and messaging on managing, treating, or  
3           preventing diabetes and diabetes complications.
- 4           d. The development or revision of detailed action plans for battling diabetes with a  
5           range of actionable items for consideration by the legislative assembly. The plans  
6           must identify proposed action steps to reduce the impact of diabetes,  
7           prediabetes, and related diabetes complications. The plan must identify expected  
8           outcomes of the action steps proposed in the following biennium while also  
9           establishing benchmarks for controlling and preventing relevant forms of  
10          diabetes.
- 11          e. The development of a detailed budget blueprint identifying needs, costs, and  
12          resources required to implement the plan identified in subdivision d. This  
13          blueprint must include a budget range for all options presented in the plan  
14          identified in subdivision 4 for consideration by the legislative assembly.
