 include production agriculture.

- b. "Primary sector business" means an individual, corporation, limited liability
 company, partnership, or association that, through a process employing
- 20 knowledge and labor, through the employment of knowledge or labor adds value
- 21 to a product produced for resale, process, or service which results in the creation
- 22 of new wealth. For purposes of this subdivision, a primary sector business adding
- 23 value to a product must also produce that product for resale.

21		product, process, or export service that <u>which</u> results in the creation of new wealth ,				
22		excluding production agriculture, if it. For purposes of this subsection, a primary sector				
23		business must also be an employer, excluding an employer engaged in production				
24	agriculture, locating to or in this state which previously had no presence in this state					
25		or expanding its operations within this state, and which meets the following eligibility				
26		criteria:				
27		a. An employer entering into an agreement, and increasing its base employment				
28		level by at least one employee, or in the case of an employer without an				
29		established base employment level in this state creating at least five employees,				
30		within the time set in the agreement, is entitled to the new jobs credit from
