AMENDMENT. Subsection 8 of section 12 of article IX of the Constitution of 13 North Dakota is amended and reenacted as follows: 14 A state hospital for the insane at the city of Jamestown, in the county of Stutsman. And 15 the legislative assembly shall appropriate twenty thousand acres of the grant of lands-16 made by the Act of Congress aforesaid for other educational and charitable institutions-17 to the benefit and for the endowment of said institution, and there A facility to provide 18 services for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities shall be located 19 at or near the city of Grafton, in the county of Walsh, an institution for the 20 feebleminded, on the grounds purchased by the secretary of the interior for a
