- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation to the state water commission for the acquisition of
- 2 flood-prone properties in the Mouse River basin; to provide legislative intent; to provide an
- 3 exemption; and to declare an emergency.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION STATE WATER COMMISSION MOUSE RIVER BASIN -
- 6 **FLOOD-PRONE PROPERTY ACQUISITION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
- 7 resources trust fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$10,650,000,
- 8 or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the state water commission for the purpose of
- 9 providing grants to political subdivisions for the acquisition of flood-prone properties in the
- 10 Mouse River basin, for the period beginning with the effective date of this Act and ending
- 11 June 30, 2017. The state water commission shall establish criteria for the awarding of grants
- 12 that must include a 25 percent local match for each grant award.
- 13 SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE INTENT MOUSE RIVER BASIN FLOOD-PRONE
- 14 **PROPERTY ACQUISITION.** It is the intent of the sixty-fourth legislative assembly that a total of
- 15 \$24,000,000 be provided by the state for the acquisition of flood-prone properties in the Mouse
- 16 River basin during the 2015-17 and 2017-2019 bienniums.
- 17 **SECTION 3. EXEMPTION.** The funds appropriated in section 1 of this Act are not subject to
- section 54-44.1-11, and any unexpended funds must be continued into the 2017-19 biennium
- and may be spent only for grants relating to the acquisition of flood-prone properties in the
- 20 Mouse River basin.
- **SECTION 4. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
