

**Sixty-fourth Legislative Assembly of North Dakota

SENATE BILL NO. 2119
(Agriculture Committee)
(At the request of the Public Service Commission)

AN ACT to provide for a legislative management study of requirements for the submission of financial statements by public warehouses and grain buyers.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - SUBMISSION OF FINANCIAL STATEMENTS BY PUBLIC WAREHOUSES AND GRAIN BUYERS. During the 2015-16 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying requirements for the submission of financial statements, to the public service commission, by public warehouses and grain buyers in this state, including the time and manner in which the statements must be submitted and confidentiality protections for the information contained therein. The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-fifth legislative assembly.
