PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 2247

That the House recede from its amendments as printed on pages 721 and 722 of the Senate Journal and pages 884 and 885 of the House Journal and that Senate Bill No. 2247 be amended as follows:

Page 1, line 1, after "A BILL" replace the remainder of the bill with " for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-01-09 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to parking meters.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 39-01-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

**39-01-09. Parking meters prohibited.**

~~It is unlawful for the~~The state of North Dakota, its political subdivisions, counties, cities, and, the state department of transportation to, or the governing body of a political subdivision, upon a simple majority vote of the governing body of the political subdivision, may establish and maintain any mechanical device ~~or devices~~ known as "parking meters", or by whatever name designated, ~~requiring the deposit therein of coins or tokens for the privilege of parking cars or other vehicles upon the streets and highways in the state of North Dakota. Any and all ordinances and resolutions now existing authorizing the establishment and maintenance of such mechanical devices or parking meters, or by whatever name designated, are hereby declared null and void. A governing body of a political subdivision may place on the ballot the question of whether metered parking should be approved for use in the political subdivision.~~
