- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 15-18.2-06.1 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to a higher education funding formula minimum amount payable; to amend and reenact
- 3 subdivision k of subsection 1 of section 15-18.2-02 and sections 15-18.2-03 and 15-18.2-05 of
- 4 the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the higher education funding formula; to repeal
- 5 section 15-18.2-04 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the institutional size factor of
- 6 the higher education funding formula; to provide for a study; to provide for a report; and to
- 7 provide legislative intent.

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8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 9 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subdivision k of subsection 1 of section 15-18.2-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 11 k. The factor for credits completed in career and technical education is 2.03.0.
- SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 15-18.2-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 14 15-18.2-03. Credit completion factor Determination.
- 1. Except as provided in subsections 2 and 3 of this section, for each institution under its control, the state board of higher education shall multiply the product determined under section 15-18.2-02 by a factor of:
 - a. 1.00 if the number of credit-hours is at least 240,000;
- b. 1.05 if the number of credit-hours is at least 180,000 but less than 240,000;
- 20 c. 1.10 if the number of credit-hours is at least 120,000 but less than
 21 180,000;
- d. 1.15 if the number of credit-hours is at least 90,000130,000 but less than
 120,000135,000;

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amended and reenacted as follows:

1 1.20 if the number of credit-hours is at least 80,000 120,000 but less than 2 90,000130,000; 3 f. 1.30 if the number of credit-hours is at least 70,000 but less than 80,000120,000; 4 1.40 if the number of credit-hours is at least 60,000 but less than 70,000; g. 5 1.50 if the number of credit-hours is at least 50,000 but less than 60,000; h. 6 i. 1.60 if the number of credit-hours is at least 40,000 but less than 50,000; 7 1.70 if the number of credit-hours is at least 30,000 but less than 40,000; and j. 8 1.80 if the number of credit-hours is less than 30,000. k. 9 If the square footage of an institution, when divided by the institution's weighted credit-2. 10 hours results in a quotient greater than 5.00, the state board of higher education shall-11 multiply the product determined under section 15-18.2-02 by a factor of 1.00. For 12 purposes of this subsection, the square footage of an institution includes real property 13 as determined by the state board of higher education in accordance with section 14 15-18.2-04. 15 If the number of credit-hours completed by an institution causes would cause a 16 decrease in the credit completion factor for that institution, the new credit completion-17 factor shall not be in effect for calculation purposes for the first two fiscal years 18 following the change compared to the credit completion factor the institution was 19 entitled to receive during the 2017-19 biennium, the state board of higher education 20 shall multiply the product determined under section 15-18.2-02 by a credit growth 21 factor of 1.0 for credits in excess of the factor the institution was entitled to receive 22 during the 2017-19 biennium. Any weighted credit-hours multiplied by a credit growth 23 factor under this section must have a weight of 1.0 under section 15-18.2-02. The 24 state board of higher education shall multiply the remaining weighted credits by the 25 credit completion factor the institution was entitled to receive during the 2017-19 26 biennium. 27 4.3. For purposes of this section, the number of credit-hours must be those determined by 28 the state board of higher education in accordance with section 15-18.2-01.

3	To determine the state aid payment to which each institution under its control is entitled, the	
4	state board of higher education shall multiply the product determined under section	
5	15-18.2-04 <u>15-18.2-03</u> by a base amount of:	
6	a. 1.	\$60.87 in the case of North Dakota state university and the university of North Dakota;
7	b. 2.	\$90.98 in the case of Dickinson state university, Mayville state university, Minot state
8		university, and Valley City state university; and
9	e. 3.	\$97.06 in the case of Bismarck state college, Dakota college at Bottineau, Lake
10		Region state college, North Dakota state college of science, and Williston state
11		college.
12	2.	An institution is entitled to an amount equal to seventy-five percent of the product
13		determined under subsection 1 for credits completed by students receiving a tuition
14		waiver pursuant to section 54-12-35.
15	SECTION 4. Section 15-18.2-06.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and	
16	enacted as follows:	
17	15-18.2-06.1. Base funding - Minimum amount payable.	
18	Notwithstanding any calculations required by this chapter, during each biennium beginning	
19	with the 2021-23 biennium, an institution may not receive less than ninety-six percent of the	
20	state aid to which the institution was entitled under this chapter during the previous biennium.	
21	SECTION 5. REPEAL. Section 15-18.2-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is repealed.	
22	SECTION 6. STATE BOARD OF HIGHER EDUCATION - STUDY OF THE HIGHER	
23	EDUCATION FUNDING FORMULA - REPORT TO THE LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT.	
24	During the period beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2022, the state board of higher	
25	education shall study the higher education funding formula, including instructional program	
26	classification factors. The state board of higher education shall provide a report to the legislative	
27	management regarding any findings or recommended changes to the funding formula by	
28	June 30, 2022.
