1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 5 of section 53-06.1-11 of the North Dakota
2 Century Code, relating to rent limits for electronic pull tab devices.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 5 of section 53-06.1-11 of the North Dakota
5 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- 6 5. For a site where bingo is not the primary game:
- 7 a. If twenty-one or paddlewheels is conducted, the monthly rent may not exceed
8 two hundred dollars multiplied by the necessary number of tables based on
9 criteria prescribed by gaming rule. For each twenty-one table with a wager
10 greater than five dollars, an additional amount up to one hundred dollars may be
11 added to the monthly rent. If pull tabs is also conducted involving only a jar bar,
12 the monthly rent for pull tabs may not exceed an additional one hundred
13 seventy-five dollars. If pull tabs is conducted involving only a dispensing device,
14 ~~electronic pull tab device,~~ or a jar bar and dispensing device ~~or electronic pull tab~~
15 ~~device,~~ the monthly rent for pull tabs may not exceed an additional three hundred
16 twenty-five dollars.
- 17 b. If twenty-one and paddlewheels are not conducted but pull tabs is conducted
18 involving either a jar bar or dispensing device, ~~or electronic pull tab device,~~ or any
19 ~~combination,~~ the monthly rent may not exceed four hundred dollars.
- 20 c. If pull tabs is conducted using one or more electronic pull tab devices, the
21 monthly rent may not exceed an additional one hundred fifty dollars per machine
22 for the first five machines in the same venue. For each additional machine in the
23 same venue beyond five, the monthly rent may not exceed an additional

- 1 seventy-five dollars per machine up to a maximum of one thousand one hundred
- 2 twenty-five dollars per month for all electronic pull tab devices in a single venue.
