- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact subsection 5 of section 57-15-17 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the authority of a school district to transfer funds from the building
- 3 fund to another political subdivision; and to amend and reenact subsections 6 and 9 of section
- 4 15.1-09-33 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the powers of a school board.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 6 of section 15.1-09-33 of the North Dakota
  Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- Purchase, sell, exchange, and improve real property. This includes the authority to
  sell, exchange, or donate real property for less than fair market value if the sale,
  exchange, or donation is to another political subdivision.
- 11 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 9 of section 15.1-09-33 of the North Dakota 12 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- Purchase, sell, exchange, improve, and lease for up to one year equipment, furniture,
  supplies, and textbooks. This includes the authority to sell, exchange, or donate
  equipment, furniture, supplies, and textbooks for less than fair market value if the sale,
  exchange, or donation is to another political subdivision.
- SECTION 3. Subsection 5 of section 57-15-17 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 19 5. If the board of a school district sells, exchanges, or donates real property to another
  20 political subdivision, the board of the school district may transfer funds from the
  21 building fund to the political subdivision for future maintenance and utility costs of the
  22 real property.
