ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2319

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 57-51.2-02 and subdivision c of

2 <u>subsection 5 of section 57-51.2-02</u> of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to oil and gas

3 agreements; to provide for application; and to provide a contingent expiration date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 57-51.2-02 of the North Dakota

6 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

7	1.	The	only taxes subject to agreement are the state's oil and gas gross production and
8		oil e	xtraction taxes attributable to production from wells located within the exterior
9		bou	ndaries of the reservation and wells located on trust properties outside reservation
10		bou	ndaries. For purposes of this chapter , "trust :
11		<u>a.</u>	"Trust properties outside reservation boundaries" means land in this state located
12			outside the exterior boundaries of a reservation which are held in trust by the
13			United States for any Indian tribe or owned by an Indian tribe or tribal member
14			subject to a restriction against alienation imposed by the United States.
15		<u>b.</u>	"Wells located within the exterior boundaries of the reservation" includes wells
16			with one or more horizontal laterals that penetrate the reservation.
17	SEC		2. AMENDMENT. Subdivision c of subsection 5 of section 57-51.2-02 of the
18	North Da	akota	Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
19		C.	The state's share of the oil and gas gross production tax revenue as divided in
20			subdivisions a and b is subject to distribution among political subdivisions as
21			provided in chapter 57-51. The definition of "wells located within the exterior
22			boundaries of the reservation" in subsection 1 may not be construed as altering
23			the physical location of a wellhead for purposes of revenue allocations among
24			political subdivisions as provided in chapter 57-51.

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1 SECTION 3. APPLICATION. This Act applies to agreements entered after July 31, 2021. 2 SECTION 4. CONTINGENT EXPIRATION DATE. This Act is effective through June 30, 3 2023, and after that date is ineffective, unless by that date the governor's office notifies the tax 4 commissioner and legislative council that an agreement under chapter 57-51.2 has been 5 entered with the governing body of a tribe in this state and, pursuant to that agreement, at least 6 one new oil and gas well on which drilling commences after July 31, 2021, situated within the 7 exterior boundaries of the reservation to which the agreement applies, has a horizontal lateral 8 that extends to federal land located outside the exterior boundaries of the reservation.
