## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 44-04-18.27 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 44-04-18.27. Applications for public employment Hiring process Confidential
  records and open records.

If a Upon the close of an application period, a public entity or any person delegated authority by a public entity to review applications or make hiring decisions receives applications from three or more applicants who meet the minimum qualifications for a vacant position, the publicentity or other person shall designate threemay designate one or more of the qualified applicants as finalists for further consideration before the public entity or other person mayissueissues an offer of employment to fill the position. However, if the public entity or otherperson does not wish to consider any of the applications further and decides not to make an offer of employment for the vacant position, the public entity need not designate any finalist. The applications and any records related to the applications which contain information that could reasonably be used to identify an applicant are confidential, except records related to finalists are open to the public after the finalists are designated. The public entity or other person reviewing applications on behalf of the public entity shall comply with all requirements for an executive session to discuss confidential applications. If, by the close of the application periodfor a vacant position, a public entity receives applications from fewer than three applicants whomeet the minimum qualifications, the applications and records related to the applications are open to the public Section 12.1-13-01 does not apply to confidential records under this section.
