1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 43-30-16 of the North Dakota
2 Century Code, relating to application and renewal fees for armed first responder course
3 instructor certification; and to amend and reenact subsection 7 of section 62.1-02-14 of the
4 North Dakota Century Code, relating to licensing of instructors of armed first responders in
5 schools.

6 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

7 **SECTION 1.** A new subsection to section 43-30-16 of the North Dakota Century Code is
8 created and enacted as follows:

9 The initial application fee for a certified course instructor for an armed first responder
10 training certification may not exceed four hundred dollars. A fee for renewal of a
11 course instructor certification for an armed first responder program may not exceed
12 three hundred dollars.

13 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 7 of section 62.1-02-14 of the North Dakota
14 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

15 7. The plan submitted by the school to the superintendent of public instruction must
16 require the selected individual to complete ~~training equivalent to the South Dakota~~
17 ~~school sentinel program as established on August 1, 2019, or complete the course~~
18 ~~established by the private investigative and security board. The private investigative~~
19 ~~and security board shall establish standards equivalent to the South Dakota school~~
20 ~~sentinel program and may license and certify course instructors, audit the course, and~~
21 ~~set administrative fees for licensure and certification.~~
