## **HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3002**

- 1 A concurrent resolution to amend and reenact section 25 of article XI of the Constitution of
- 2 North Dakota, relating to authorizing sports betting.

## 3 STATEMENT OF INTENT

- 4 This measure requires the legislative assembly to authorize sports betting to be conducted in
- 5 the state and licensed and regulated by the state.
- 6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA,
- 7 THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
- 8 That the following proposed amendment to section 25 of article XI of the Constitution of North
- 9 Dakota is agreed to and must be submitted to the qualified electors of North Dakota at the
- 10 general election to be held in 2024, in accordance with section 16 of article IV of the
- 11 Constitution of North Dakota.
- 12 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 25 of article XI of the Constitution of North Dakota is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 14 Section 25. The legislative assembly shallmay not authorize any game of chance, lottery,
- or gift enterprises, under any pretense, or for any purpose whatever. However, except the
- 16 legislative assembly shall:
- 17 <u>1. Shall</u> authorize the state of North Dakota to join a multi-state lottery for the benefit of the state of North Dakota, and, the legislative assembly may.
- 19 <u>2.</u> <u>May</u> authorize by law bona fide nonprofit veterans', charitable, educational, religious,
- or fraternal organizations, civic and service clubs, or such other public-spirited
- organizations as it may recognize, to conduct games of chance when the entire net
- proceeds of such games of chance are to be devoted to educational, charitable,
- patriotic, fraternal, religious, or other public-spirited uses.
- 24 <u>3. May authorize sports betting on professional sports to be conducted in the state and</u>
- 25 licensed and regulated by the state.
