Item Description

Airport infrastructure fund - Exemption - Section 3 of Senate Bill No. 2006 provides that any unexpended funds from the airport infrastructure fund in Section 1 of Chapter 6 of the 2019 Session Laws is not subject to the provisions of North Dakota Century Code Section 54-44.1-11, and any unexpended funds may be expended during the 2021-23 biennium and the 2023-25 biennium to provide grants to airports.

State Fiscal Recovery Fund - Airport grants - Section 1 of Senate Bill No. 2345 appropriated \$5 million of one-time funding from the State Fiscal Recovery Fund for airport grants during the 2021-23 biennium.

Status/Result

The airport infrastructure fund did not receive any deposits from oil and gas tax revenues, and as a result no funds were continued into the 2021-23 biennium.

As of March 31, 2022, no airport grants have yet been awarded. The commission will begin issuing the grants in June 2022.
