

HUMAN SERVICES PROGRAMS - REFERENCES

This memorandum identifies references to human services-related topics which are located throughout the Constitution of North Dakota and the North Dakota Century Code. The following table is not an exhaustive list, but is designed to be an illustrative list to reflect the range of topics and breadth of distribution through Century Code. The search is based on a review of Century Code and a search of terms such as "poor," "welfare," and "human services."

CONSTITUTION OF NORTH DAKOTA

Section 18 of Article X of the Constitution of North Dakota is a general prohibition of the state or one of its political subdivisions giving a gift or donation to or in aid of any person. However, the prohibition makes an exception for "reasonable support of the poor." This section authorizes the state and its political subdivisions to provide human services benefits to North Dakotans.
